#### NEWS FROM THE NATIONAL CORVETTE MUSEUM (NCM) May 2024 Dave Jones (Email: oneregal@yahoo.com)

For a decade the Museum has offered the "Corvette Experience" at its Motorsports Park (MSP), providing driving experience on its 3.2 mile, 23-turn road course. In 2024 the MSP is launching a new "Driving Academy." The new academy is ideal for the Corvette enthusiast to improve their driving skills in an entry-level driving school. The school offers a combination of classroom sessions, paddock activities and on-track driving exercises. Expert instructors provide high-level instruction tailored to a wide array of skills and comfort levels. Participants have the opportunity to enjoy the Corvette's incredible performance while learning the fundamentals of high-performance driving. The curriculum provides a wide array of topics, including vehicle dynamics, cornering techniques, braking strategies and much more. After the classroom, the exercises move to the paddock area and ultimately to driving on the 3.2 mile road course. The experience also includes admission to the NSM and a lunch voucher for the Stingray Grill. For and added \$30 participants may invite a guest to the classroom sessions, lunch and a tour of the NCM. For an additional fee the guest can also put on a helmet and experience the thrill of riding as passenger with a professional driver in a 20-minute ride-along. Did you know that in the 1990's there were plans for "The National Corvette Museum CORVETTE LAND" that included a water park, meeting area with restaurant, covered music pavilion, kart track, putt-putt golf course and much more. In keeping with the plan, the NCM has now obtained rights to 8.05 acres, which is currently an RV dealership, adjoining the existing NCM park. The NSM is asking for support to help fund this additional acreage to the existing park. At the top of the web page click on "Support" and find the article "Imagining our Future."

In shopping news, the Vintage Shop is now open at the Museum and online at corvettestore.com. The shop sells memorabilia from throughout the history of the Corvette. These items have been donated by the public for resale in the shop. Vintage jackets, T-shirts and accessories can be found here. Also rare items are available such as a VHS rewind machine shaped a like a 1963 Corvette. If you wish to donate items you can use the corvettestore.com web sight to find out more. Also now available through the corvette store are personalized checkered flag racing decorative sherpa blankets. These are available for the C1-C6 generations for the purchase price of \$89.95. The blankets are 1/8" thick, 100% polyester, 50 x 60 inches and can be personalized with name, VIN number, year etc. A great gift for the Corvette enthusiast.

# What I Did to My Corvette


#### Steve Argubright, C8 - CORVETTE WOES

I dropped off my C8 at the local Chevrolet dealer on **April 8** after it began lurching during slow braking and acceleration. I returned on **April 15** and was told the symptoms were still being diagnosed. I stopped back on **April 17**. The C8 was still sitting in the service lane. I was informed that their Transmission <u>Specialist's last day on the job was **April 19**. **April 22** - Service Rep said a new Transmission Specialist had been hired but it will take time before he can start to work. In the meantime, a transmission part has been ordered. If the part does not fix the problem, it looks like a new transmission is in my future. 
